VILLAGE OF RICHMOND.

A village of about 500 souls, settled in 1818 by the discharged officers and men of the 99th and 100th Regiments of the line, hence the name the military settlement of Richmond—named as a courtesy to the Duke of Richmond. For a number of years pensioners were paid in this historic little town, and even at this day relics of the old settlers are in possession of some of the residents. It is said the first church built in the county was constructed here. Probably very few towns in the country were laid out with greater precision than was Richmond. The roll shows a falling off during the past five years. At present there are but 4 stores, 4 churches, 3 shoeshops, 2 hotels, 1 school, 2 harness shops and a town hall. The Warden of the County, Dr. Beatty, is Reeve of Richmond, Mr. Thos. Miller, Clerk.
