The Newfoundland War Contingent Association is appointed by the Central Prisoners of War Committee to handle all matters appertaining to the forwarding of parcels and money to Newfoundland P. of W. in Germany.

The N. W. C. A. forward a regular supply from London to Germany as follows:-

(a) Food. Three parcels per man per fortnight containing such things as tinned beef, tinned salmon, biscuits, milk, sugar, margarine, dripping, baked beans, carbolic
