LOCAL MARKET.

The smaller lines were very well represented here today, as the bulk of the offerings consisted of hogs and oysters; there was a fair demand and prices were steady.

Grain.—There was quite a large delivery of oats today, sales were brisk at \$1.05 to \$1.07 per cwt. mostly at \$1.06. Hay and straw.—There were 40 loads of hay on the market, sales were fair at \$8 to \$8.50 per ton; only the best loads sold at the highest figure. Straw was dull of sale, as the loads were wet; prices were unchanged.

Butter and Eggs.—There was not much offered by the farmers; several loads were brought in by country storekeepers. Eggs were made at 21c to 22c for choice cracks, and 20c for the best pound lots. Eggs were not very plentiful, and sold at 20c to 22c per dozen, the latter price for small lots of strictly fresh-laid. Apples and potatoes were in small supply, and prices were as quoted. Not much poultry offered; prices were unchanged. Dressed Hogs.—About 50 offered, sales were brisk at \$5.25 to \$5.50 per cwt, mostly at \$5.50. Butchers' Meats.—Not a very brisk trade in this line, prices were steady.

TORONTO JUNCTION. Feb. 12.—The market was pretty brisk this morning, notwithstanding the fact that the price of exported hogs was lower; all the cattle were picked out before 11 o'clock. Butchers' cattle sold at about the same price as last week. Hogs remained unchanged. The run today was 91 cars, consisting of 1,567 cattle, 75 sheep, 10 hogs and 20 calves. H. Hunsberrist bought 34 sheep, lambs and calves at \$4.75 to \$5 per cwt. Crawford & Co. sold 100 head of good, 1,400 lbs. at \$4.50 per cwt; 1 load of exporters, 1,225 lbs. at \$4.50; 3 loads of butchers, 1,125 lbs. at \$4.50 per cwt; 1 load of butchers, 500 lbs. at \$4.50.
