made his only plea. "I ask you to have mercy upon me," said the prisoner. "I have a family of five little children and my wife. It was a drunken brawl and I did not know what I was doing. Have mercy

Before sentence was pronounced Mr. Bartlett addressed the court, outlining the details of the fight, which he re-peatedly termed "a' drunken brawl."
