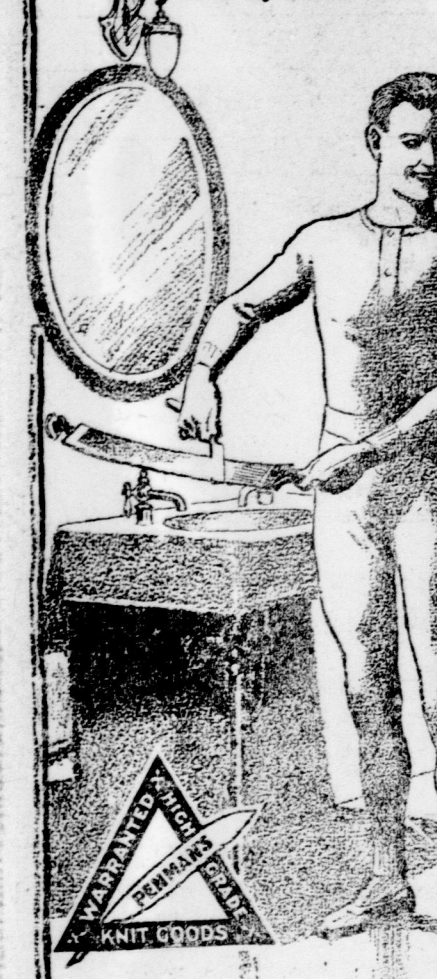

RUSSIA WITHDRAWS TROOPS FROM FINLAND

Action Makes Good Impression in Sweden—No Invasion Feared.

London, Nov. 14.—A Copenhagen dispatch to the Star says: "News from Helsinki, Finland, states that the Russians have withdrawn troops from the east and west of Finland to join the main Russian army, indicating that Russia's fear of a Swedish invasion has vanished."
This withdrawal of the military strength from Finland has made a good impression in Sweden.

REICHSBANK EXCITED

Takes Measures to Stop Inflow of German Loans From Abroad.

Berlin, via The Hague, Nov. 13.—Via London, Nov. 14.—3:25 a.m.—The Reichsbank today took action designed to check the inflow of German loans from abroad. A considerable volume of German bonds, with a British stamp, having recently reached Germany, the Reichsbank sees there an attempt of the British to depress the price of the bonds and discredit Germany's financial solidity.
Ludolf Havenstein, president of the Reichsbank, today conferred with the Board of directors, after which the committee gave out a press statement that the Reichsbank would permanently sever all business relations with banks acting as agents for such foreign operations.

FARM ACTIVITY IN FALL ALLEVIATES SPRING CRUSH

Good Day's Fall Plowing, With Two Days' Labor in Spring
"Feed Your Grain and Hay," is Advice to Farmers.

Do Canadian farmers appreciate the value of doing as much farm work in the fall as they possibly can? Do they appreciate the fact that a good winter work in fall ploughing is worth two days' labor in the spring? Apparently not. If a survey of the country from the window of a train or a trip through the country by automobile is made.
The average farmer, after the harvest is over, the threshing done, the roots in the cellar, and the silo full to capacity, sits down and says to himself: "Well, I guess we've had a pretty good year, and I think I'll take a rest."
