First Recital of Season.
Charming variety marked the Hungarian, Norwegian, Polish and Russian program arranged by Mrs. A. D. Jordan, which was presented at the first regular recital of the Women's Music Club in the Normal School on Thursday evening.
Russian, Polish and Hungarian dances in costume added life and color to the recital, these including the Russian Gopak, the animated Polish "Kra-kowiak," presented by Marion Stark and Gladys Tullett, and the Hungarian "Czardus," in which those taking part were Mary Jane McHale, Lillian McCormick, Audrey Farmcombe, Peggy Lyne-Evans, Marion Beattie, Hazel Farbridge, Antoinette Gilles, Julia Elba. Noteworthy in connection with the folk dances, with their strongly accented rhythm, was the graceful movement of hands and arms.
Mrs. Frederick Schofield's clear soprano voice was heard to advantage in

"Songs My Mother Taught Me" (Dvorak), and "The Nightingale" (Hajdau Kjerulff).
Miss Viola Stevens delighted with the "Norwegian Echo Song."
Mr. Carmen Learn sang with dramatic effect "The Siege of Kazan" (Moussourgsky).
Miss Mabel Stevens, whose playing is marked by clean technique and fine artistic appreciation, played Liebestraume No. 3 (Liszt); "Berceuse" (Chopin) and "Gloire on 42" (Glazounow). Breadth of conception, style and finish characterized the interpretation of Chopin's sonata in B minor (Largo, Presto non tanto). So insistent were echoes that she responded with a fascinating and colorful "Oriental Dance" by Peterkin.
Mr. A. D. Jordan played the accompaniments.

**GAINS NEW TRIAL
IN BRIBERY CASE**
Cecil Smith, Windsor, May Be
Released On \$20,000
Cash Bail.
TORONTO, Dec. 16.—Cecil Smith, a liquor importer, Windsor, convicted of corruptly offering William Allen, a peace officer, a sum of money, with intent to interfere corruptly with the due administration of justice, is granted a new trial by the second divisional court, with Mr. Justice Riddell dissenting.
But Justices Riddell and Middleton insist on cash or surety of bail of \$20,000, the order not to issue until the attorney-general is consulted, and Mr. Justice Lennox, speaking for himself, says: "I should think there would be no hardship in retaining the prisoner in close custody till the trial, the only absolute guarantee to my mind that he will still appear for trial when called upon. There should be no escape from this, if he is alive."
The trial judge's stated case: "Was I right in law when I stated to the jury, 'It matters not in my opinion whether Smith knew that Allen was an officer, so far as the offence is concerned?'"
Mr. Justice Riddell's answer is "Yes," but his colleagues say "No."
