THE DUTCH GOVERNMENT is already preparing for the international colonial exhibition to be held in Amsterdam from May to October, 1883. No country but Spain now squeezes a handsome revenue out of its colonies except Holland. The Malays in Java are practically all slaves still.

AT A RECENT TEST of the eighty-ton gun made at Woolwich, and the 100-ton gun made at Elswick, it was incidentally shown that English powder is much better than German powder. The 100-ton gun firing the latter retarded velocity of 1335 feet per second with a pressure upon the bore of fourteen tons; firing the former, the velocity was 1545 feet per second, with a pressure of only twelve tons.

THE PRINTERS of Leipzig have just celebrated their four hundredth anniversary of the introduction of printing into that town. In 1483 Andreas Preiserer, a professor of theology, set up the first printing press in Leipzig. He made a present of it to a monastery on condition that the monks would pray for his soul. Now Leipzig has eighty-two printing establishments, with 451 steam presses and 871 hand presses, employing over 12,000 people.

PROF. HUTCHINSON in one of his lectures mentions a very interesting fact ascertained in Berlin. Among Roman Catholics, who prohibit marriages between persons who are near blood relatives, the proportion of deaf mutes is one to 3000; among Protestants, who view such marriages as permissible, the proportion is one to 2000; while among Jews, who encourage intermarriage with blood relations, the deaf mutes are as one in 400.

THE ENGLISH NEWSPAPERS give us a remarkable illustration of the way in which matters and things, even including religious things, are managed in England. St. Mary's chapel, in Park street London, has existed as a place of worship for upward of one hundred and seventy years. Some might think it the property of the Lord, or at least that the Lord had gained a title by prescription and undisputed occupancy for over a century; but it turns out that St. Mary's is the property of the Duke of Westminster, and he has determined to pull it down. The congregation delegated Lord Ebury to present, on its behalf, a memorial petition, asking him to reconsider his determination; but the duke declined to do so, although he was informed that if he would he should not be out of pocket one penny. His reply was: "It is too late." The duke is one of the wealthiest men in the world, and few of them could better afford to indulge in a little sentiment. He has evidently no taste for it. He believes in "it" quite as strongly as he does in the church, to put the statement as mildly as possible.

THE SISTERS of St. AUGUSTINE'S, Kilburn, London, have put an entire new construction on the apostolic injunction to feed the hungry. The waitresses are the orphans whom this society adopts and educates. All honor to so useful and practical a work. To give the workmen in London a really good dinner, at the prices which conditions where there is no oblation to drink, to serve it with decency and cleanliness, in a manner which educates his respect, is a work of no mean order. The sisters are thus described: "They are in black serge gowns, flannel head-dress, with spotted linen bands, playing cards, book, and soap-ladle, as busy as bees and as quiet, and so clean. The waitresses are another surprise. Not a hungry, greasy, spit-lubbing wailer, nor a sulky, sooty slattern, but a modest and little maiden twelve or thirteen years of age, dressed in a blue frock with a neat overall apron and a mob cap." The tables are marble slabs. The tariff is low and the quantity liberal. Soup, good warming, nourishing stuff, with plenty of meat and vegetable backbone, four cents; bread, one cent. There is cash on delivery. Breakfast, pudding ten cents, potatoes two cents. Total dinner seventeen cents. If by doing this good work, the sisters can help to support the orphanage as well as feed the workmen they will have combined two good works in one. There are some admirable religious societies in Toronto, and here is a new idea for them.

VOLUNTARY WRITINGS, containing One result of the seizure at the custom house of Paine's Age of Reason and Voltaire's Pocket Theology, has been directed to the attention of a large number of persons to these books who would otherwise have

remained in ignorance of them. It is reported that the books, refused admission at the custom house, are to be reprinted here. The question has been raised whether the Pocket Theology is a work of Voltaire at all, or at least in a work of Voltaire. Doubtless it is not identical with the later editions; but there is reason to believe that it is translated from the first edition of the Philosophical Dictionary. This is the opinion of literary men best acquainted with the works of Voltaire. This work was published under different titles, in different editions; once under one that might be rendered in English, Pocket Dictionary; whence doubtless has come Pocket Theology. In the seventh edition, this article appears under the title; La Raison par Alphabet.

It is a curious fact, as Voltaire himself distinctly states, that some of the articles to which objection is taken at the Toronto custom house were written by eminent divines. Voltaire copied right and left, sometimes in his own words, *Epistolæ seu page d'un livre connu*. And he adds that he took whole articles from living *des personnes en renom, parmi lesquelles on compte de savans pasteurs, parmi lesquels on compte de savans pasteurs, parmi lesquels on compte de savans pasteurs*. And proceeding to particulars, he specifies those he copied the *Apocalypse, Christianisme, Meurtre, Miracles*. In the article on miracles, a whole page is taken from Dr. Middleton without any mark to indicate a quotation. Several pages were taken from Bishop Warburton. The manuscripts of Du Marsy were extensively drawn upon. The article on Genesis was written by a learned friend of the Prince of Wales; not Bubb Dodington we may be sure; but while the customs authorities think they have been confiscating Voltaire, it is quite possible that they have been confiscating Warburton and Middleton to the flames. It cannot be necessary to add a single word to these facts.

Voltaire has been accused of denying the authorship of pieces he had written; whether this accusation be well founded or not it is certain that things which he did not write were ascribed to him; and he would not be likely to name as the authors of articles published by him (well-known writers of previous times for living men; since to do so would have been to expose himself to certain detection. And Voltaire, whatever else he was, was not a simplicit.

PROMISES TO MARRY. The case which was tried before Mr. Justice Cameron last September, in which John Faulkner, a bachelor, owing property to the amount of forty or fifty thousand dollars, promised to marry Mrs. Jane Tillson, a widow whose husband had been one of his tenants, and a written memorandum of the agreement was drawn up and a day set for the ceremony, but did not do so, and is still fresh in the minds of our readers. The American press have made several comments on Justice Cameron's decision. The New York Sun of Wednesday has a column article on the legal aspect of the suit. It will be remembered that soon after making the promise Faulkner seems to have repented of his step, and when the day appointed for the marriage arrived he was not ready to proceed, and the ceremony had to be postponed. He was always unprepared to enter upon matrimony, but Mrs. Tillson was always ready, and clung to him patiently.

Finally, he seems to have struck upon the idea of treating her in such a rude and insulting manner in the presence of other persons that it would be impossible for her to submit to it without degradation. She discontinued her efforts to bring the marriage about, and commenced suit against him for breach of promise, claiming damages in the sum of five thousand dollars. Faulkner did not improve in his offensive behavior toward the plaintiff after the suit was instituted; but when the case was called on for trial, he took the whole foundation from under her feet by offering through his counsel, and then there to marry her. It was plainly impossible for her at that stage of her relations, with any sense of decency or self-respect, to accept this offer; and yet the judge was called to say that he did not see how the suit could be maintained under the existing law, if she declined it.

Breach of promise law, as frequently laid down in the courts, is peculiar in its respect. In other contracts, if there is a refusal to perform, and suit for damages for the breach is commenced, and it is later to carry out the agreement is then too late; but a different rule has been enacted in respect to contracts of marriage. The plaintiff's counsel argued that the defendant, by his intolerable conduct, had made it impossible for her to accept his offer at that stage, and that this distinguished the case from others; but Judge Cameron doubted the soundness of the distinction. "Moreover," said he in effect, "the manner you prove this defendant to have been, the less damage do you prove and the weaker do you make your ground for recovering a verdict. You sue for damages incurred by this man's refusal to marry the plaintiff. It is the first place, he says he now is willing to marry, and in the second place you show him to have behaved so contemptibly that if he persisted in his refusal it ought to be regarded as a benefit rather than an injury to her." The plaintiff's counsel argued that his client had a share in the defendant's property, to which she would have been entitled as his wife. The judge, however, adhered to his view of the case, and although he finally allowed it to go to trial, it was with instructions to the jury that caused them very speedily to bring in a verdict for the defendant.

It has often been said that breach of promise suits ought not to be favored; and shows that the action of the house of commons such as this is the sentiment entertained by a large proportion of Englishmen. But the answer to this—and a sufficient one—has been that there ought to be some remedy for the injury that may be done to a confiding woman by a faithless man, after permitting her to wait for years in the belief that he would fulfill a promise to marry her, heartlessly forsakes her. It, however, the view of the law taken by Judge Cameron is correct, it is clearly in the power of any man, if he be sufficiently mean, to break such a promise and still avoid legal liability for it. When he gets ready to discard the woman to whom he has pledged his faith, he need only give course of such cruel conduct toward her as a woman can endure; and if this does not suffice to free him, he can flatterly refuse to fulfill his promise, compel her to begin suit, wait until the case is ready for trial, and offer to comply with his contract then, but in so contemptuous and offensive a manner as to avoid the acceptance of the offer. The more outrageous his behavior, the weaker the cause of action against him. It may be said that in one sense Judge Cameron is right, and that a woman ought to be glad to escape marrying such a fellow; but it cannot be denied that if he disguises his true character, and leads her to wait for him until other matrimonial chances are practically lost, she has been subjected to injustice, in which there ought to be some remedy, even if it be by way of punishing him rather than of compensating her. Many women would never think of seeking redress for such a wrong in the courts; yet there may be cases in which they ought to have the right to do so. As society is constituted, the prospect of marriage is more important to the average woman than any business venture to the average man; but it is clearly not so well protected in law.

THE SPORTING WORLD

THE DEFEAT OF THE ATLANTA. NEW YORK, Nov. 9.—In 1851 the American yacht America bore away from the London yacht club's flying flag; three years later she was captured by the Cambria, two by the Triton, two by the Countess of Dufferin, and one by the Canadian yacht Albatross, the last of which she defeated yesterday. None of the foreign yachts met a more signal defeat than did the Atlanta in to-day's race with the Mischief. At 11.55 the yachts were off. The Mischief carried her working topsail in addition to mainsail, jib, and a flying-jib, and when she turned the lightship and was one mile on her way home she met the Atlanta on a bearing for the lightship. After a half hour the Atlanta came and the Mischief gave her a hearty cheer. Her captain, Mr. Dan Duffin, her crew, and her sails were better manned and had her sails better set. She had the services of Capt. Dan Duffin, her captain, Mr. Cuthbert, sailed her. The following are the times of the start, finish and actual and estimated time:

The challenge was that he would kill seventy on the 11th, and the stakes were \$100 on this part of the match. Seventy birds having been killed, \$50 a side were awarded to the victor. Carver killed these without a miss.
