

COMING HOME

The larger the group with which you are travelling, the more questions you will be expected to answer about Canadian Customs procedures, exemptions and free allowances at your point of re-entry into Canada. The Department of National Revenue publishes a free booklet entitled, "I Declare" which will give you most of the basic information you will need to assist your members with their personal declarations. Copies are available from the Department or from any passport or customs office in Canada and at all Canadian international airports.

A LAST THOUGHT BEFORE PARTING

If you have followed the recommendations in this guide, you will be in pretty good shape to get your tour under way. Remember that even the best laid schemes of mice and men go awry and, however well prepared you are, you must be ready to deal with the unexpected.
