

Ottawa, June 27th, 1980

Excellency,

I have the honour to refer to your Excellency's Note No. EBS 1906 dated June 23rd, 1980, regarding an Agreement between our two Governments concerning the reciprocal granting of authorization to permit licensed amateur radio operators of either country to operate their stations in the other country during their stay there, under certain conditions.

I am pleased to inform Your Excellency that the Government of Chile accepts the provisions contained in the Note and that the Spanish texts attached to this Note and which correspond to the English and French texts proposed by Your Excellency constitute an Agreement between our two countries, which enter into force today and shall remain in force until termination upon sixty days' notice, in writing, by either Government.

Please accept, Excellency, the assurances of my highest consideration.
