

**Monday, July 20 (Cont'd)**

- 2.40 p.m. Arrive near centre of new town. (Slow drive for approximately five blocks which are marked. Then fast drive to old town. Slow drive for approximately five blocks then fast drive to Sir John Franklin School.)
- 2.50 p.m. The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh arrive at Sir John Franklin School, leave their automobile and proceed to a special platform. The Commissioner presents members of the Northwest Territories Council and their wives. The Mayor presents the City Council, leaders of community organizations and their wives, four Indian chiefs, and a small group of Eskimos and their wives. Following presentations, The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh are asked to walk amongst groups of Veterans, Girl Guides and Boy Scouts.
- 3.10 p.m. The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh re-enter their automobile and leave for Con Mine.  
Seating in automobiles:  
As before
- 3.15 p.m. Arrive at Con Mine.  
The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh alight from their automobile.  
The Mayor presents the Mine Manager (E. J. Colthorp, Esquire) and Mrs. Colthorp. Mr. Colthorp presents members of his staff.  
Mr. Colthorp and a member of his staff conduct The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh to the central part of the mill for a short explanation of the operation. Following this the Royal Party proceed to the refining area to see the refining process and the pouring of a gold brick.
