

This exchange program is an IAS program for up to three students of the "Fachbereich Bauingenieurwesen", which operates independently from the Baden-Württemberg-Ontario exchange program. In contrast to most IAS schemes, this scheme also provides the opportunity for three Canadian students to study at the University of Stuttgart.

Applicants are screened and selected by a committee of representatives of the "Lehrstuhl für Hydraulik und Grundwasser" and the "Akademisches Auslandsamt". In Canada, students are selected by their department.

The IAS exchange scheme is a "Teilstipendium" which includes a tuition waiver, a flat rate of DM 2000 for travel expenses and a monthly allowance of DM 600 for German participants. Canadian students can participate in an Intensive Language Course in German and are offered a work term with a suitable company.

The exchange usually lasts one year, during the time of which students remain enrolled at their home university. German students usually receive leave status.
