His Excellency Bredo Stabell today presented his letter of Credence as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Norway to Canada.

The ceremony took place at the Supreme Court at 10:00 a.m. The Chief of Protocol, Mr. Henry F. Davis, presented the Ambassador to the Deputy Governor General, the Honourable Patrick Kerwin, P.C., Chief Justice of Canada. Mr. Norman Robertson, Under Secretary of State for External Affairs, and Colonel A.G. Cherrier, Assistant Secretary to the Governor General, were in attendance on the Deputy Governor General on this occasion.

Mr. Bredo Stabell was born in 1908. He entered the Foreign Service in 1940 and has served in Washington, Brussels, New York and Paris.

From 1954 until his present appointment, Mr. Stabell has been the Director of Legal Affairs in the Norwegian Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
