PRAYERS

By unanimous consent, the notice of motion standing in the name of the honourable Member for Halifax-East Hants (Mr. McCleave), for the concurrence in the Third Report of the Standing Joint Committee on Regulations and other Statutory Instruments, presented to the House on Thursday, November 7, 1974, was dropped.

A petition was presented by the honourable Member for St. Paul's (Mr. Roberts).

The Order being read for the consideration of the Business of Supply;

Pursuant to Special Order made Monday, December 9, 1974, Mr. Sharp, seconded by Mr. Drury, moved,—That the Green Paper entitled "Members of Parliament and Conflict of Interest" tabled on November 27, 1974, be referred to the Standing Committee on Privileges and Elections; and

That, after the Committee has concluded its deliberations and submitted its report on the aforementioned matter, it be authorized to consider and make recommendations upon the subject-matter of Ministers and conflict of interest and Public Servants and conflict of interest.

And debate arising thereon;

Mr. Stanfield, seconded by Mr. Wagner, moved in amendment thereto,—That paragraph 2 of the motion be deleted and the following substituted:

"That the Committee be authorized to report on the aforementioned Green Paper after first considering and making recommendations on the subject-matter of Ministers and conflict of interest and Public Servants and conflict of interest."

After debate thereon, at 9.45 o'clock p.m., Mr. Speaker interrupted the proceedings;
