

Order Paper Questions

Board's regulatory function; recommendations on nuclear safety related research and development supported by the Board; recommendations on "appropriate" or "acceptable" levels of safety for the various activities regulated by the Board, and on methods of defining and demonstrating these levels; and advice on major safety issues arising from the regulatory process.

(iii) To establish, with the concurrence of the President or a designated officer of the AECB, subcommittees or working groups to carry out committee work.

(b) In 1982-83, the Committee considered the following topics: basic safety requirements for nuclear power plants;

principles for the management of radioactive waste; the role of human factors in nuclear safety; the perception of risk; review of the AECB proposed program for research; a policy on quality assurance for nuclear activities; and the concept of negligible dose.

(c) The Committee met five times during 1982-83 for a total of seven days. Also, the working groups met several times. The Committee is required to meet at least two times per year.

(d) In 1982-83, the Committee did not publish any formal reports other than the revised version of ACNS-2, "A proposed statement on safety objectives for nuclear activities in Canada", which was subsequently endorsed by the AECB.
