The amount of really original and constructive thinking going on in our universities to-day is less than we are willing to admit. It may be that education is not attracting men of parts because they can have more freedom and more financial reward elsewhere. Until university salaries are on a par which reward brains outside the walls then we shall continue to attract those who are not of the very highest quality.

The whole matter of the graduate school can be summed up in one word - MONEY.
