

62. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,*—That no person shall or may be convicted of any offence contrary to the provisions of this Act in a summary way, after the expiration of six months from the time when any such offence shall or may have been committed.

No person to be summarily convicted after six months from time of offence.

93. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,*—That all monies arising from such penalties, fines and forfeitures, as are inflicted or authorised to be imposed by this Act, shall be from time to time paid to the Commissioners, to be by them applied in repairing and maintaining the turnpike roads and disposed of for the purposes of this Act.

Moneys arising from fines, &c., to be paid to Commissioners for purposes of this Act.
