Duties of Officers
(a)President (and in his absence a Vice-President) shall preside at all the meetings of the Association and perform the usual functions of the Chairman. In the absence of both President and Vice-Presidents the members present may appoint a Chairman from amongst themselves. The President, Vice-Presidents or Chairman (not being a representative) shall not vote at any meeting except where there is an equality of votes exclusive of his own, in which case he shall have the casting vote.
