AN ACT

*To Incorporate the Dominion Commercial Travellers'  
Association.*

WHEREAS James A. Cantlie, David L. Lockerby, George Forbes, Frederick Massey, Gustave Piché, Ralph B. Hutchison, Charles Hutchison, George Sumner, Alexander Gowdey, John Rogers, James O'Brien, Alexander W. Acheson, and Rollo C. Simpson, have by their petition represented that it would be for the interest of the "Dominion Commercial Travellers' Association," of which they are members, that it should be incorporated, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of their petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

1. The said James A. Cantlie, David L. Lockerby, George Forbes, Frederick Massey, Gustave Piché, Ralph B. Hutchison, Charles Hutchison, George Sumner, Alexander Gowdey, John Rogers, James O'Brien, Alexander W. Acheson, and Rollo C. Simpson, and such other persons as are now, or shall hereafter become members of the said Association and their successors, shall be and they are hereby constituted a body politic and corporate under the name of the "Dominion Commercial Travellers' Association," having its head office in the City of Montreal, with power to purchase, receive, acquire, hold and enjoy property both real and personal, to and for the use of the said Corporation, and to sell, alienate, exchange mortgage or lease the same: Provided always, that the said Corporation shall dispose of any real estate by it received, except such as may be required for the actual use and occupation of the said Association, within five years from the date of its acquisition.
