which there are fo many opinions, my end will be fully answered, and they will, perhaps, be then convinced, that if any positive fixed general fystem could be adopted, that of contract, which was established by my predecessor, Sir William Howe, and continued during my command, was the best under the probable duration of offenfive war, in which fecrecy and celerity of operation demands that the public stores and warlike depots of every kind should be amply provided, and ever ready at an instant to answer the call of the commander in chief.
