THE prisoner being brought into court attended by the provost martial, and all the witnesses, and every other person who thought proper to be present, being admitted, the court was fworn agreeably to act of parliament, the order for the court's affembling being first read, together with a warrant from the president, appointing Mr. John Tyson to execute the office of deputy judge advocate on this occasion, the judge advocate of the fleet and his deputy being absent. The annexed letter from Mr. Thomas Huchenson Wynter to Herbert Sawyer, Esq; rear admiral of the white, and commander in chief, &c. &c. &c. dated the 28th October, 1787, per log, and containing the charges against the prisoner, was then read; and all the witnesses being ordered to withdraw, the profecutor wanted to exhibit another A 2 charge
