HIGHLAND SOCIETY OF NOVA-SCOTIA.—The Highland Society was instituted in London, in the year 1778, and Incorporated in 1816; and the Highland Society of Nova Scotia was instituted at Halifax, on Thursday the 31st May, 1838. The principal object of this Society is the introduction of suitable Schoolmasters and the importation of books from the Mother Country into the eastern parts of the Province, and the Island of Cape Breton, so as to diffuse more widely among Scotsmen and their descendants, whether Highland or Lowland, Catholic or Protestant, the blessings of a sound practical and moral education. The annual subscription is ten shillings a year (in the town of Halifax.) Any person subscribing five pounds shall be a member for life.
