CUPS 112 YEARS OLD.

Rev. John Harris will dispense Holy Communion at Mill Bank and Bartibogue next Sunday. The silver communion cups which were in use in the first Presbyterian church built in northern New Brunswick at Moorfield in 1805, will be used for the first time since the church was destroyed in the Miramichi fire in 1825. The cups are antique in design, of solid silver, and the cups bear the inscription "Miramichi Presbyterian Congregation, 1805." They were resurrected by Rev. D. Henderson shortly after he came to Chatham and are now in his possession.
