Montreal.

Professor Campbell, Mr. Romanes, and Mr. Mowat, to revise the Records of the Presbytery of Montreal.

Hamilton.

Mr. McKid, Dr. Liddell, and Dr. Black, to revise the Records of the Presbytery of Hamilton.

Quebec.

Mr. Cruickshank, Mr. Maclaurin, and Mr. Brodie, to revise the Records of the Presbytery of Quebec.

Kingston.

The Records of the Presbytery of Kingston having also been produced, Mr. Fraser, Mr. George Bell, and Mr. Petrie, were appointed to revise so much of them as have been engrossed since the meeting of Synod at Kingston.

Adjournment.

The Synod adjourned till three o'clock to-morrow ;—and was closed with prayer.
