

PRESS MUST OBEY GERMAN DICTATION The Hague, Oct. 18, via London, 5 p.m.—The Socialist newspaper Vorwarts, of Berlin, was published again today, after being suppressed for ten days. In a notice to its readers, signed by the directorate of the Social-Democratic party, it states that the Vorwarts was suppressed by the order of the military commander of Brandenburg on account of its opposition to the activities of the opponents of Chancellor Von Bethmann-Hollweg. When revocation of the order was asked, the newspaper says, the military commander ordered certain changes in the staff of the editorial department so that necessary guarantees might be had that in future the paper would adhere strictly to the assurances given to the authorities shortly after the outbreak of the war.
