

THIRD WITNESS
FOR PROSECUTION (cont'd)

- A. 61 The accused was paraded to the Quartermaster's store.
- Q. 62 And he was shown the articles?
- A. 62 I can't say that. When we received his kit we listed the articles and held them until such a time as we had to produce them.
- Q. 63 Did you make any kit inspection yourself in the case of the accused?
- A. 63 No, I did not myself, my R.Q.M.S. did.
- Q. 64 You were not present?
- A. 64 Yes, I was present.
- Q. 65 You did not really see the articles?
- A. 65 No, I did not.
- Q. 66 Were there any recoveries?
- A. 66 No, there were no recoveries at all, that is when the accused was apprehended and brought to the Q.M. Store.
- Q. 67 That's the point that the Court does not understand. How is it that the accused's kit was picked up and no recoveries made?
- A. 67 We did actually pick up some of his kit, but when the accused was apprehended and paraded to the Q.M. Store there was no recoveries at all.
- Q. 68 Where do you show credit to the accused for the articles picked up at his home?
- A. 68 On our inventory list of his kit, Sir.
- Q. 69 Do you know if on the date of the kit inspection any recoveries were made?
- A. 69 I don't understand your question, Sir, do you mean when he was apprehended and brought back.
- Q. 70 Yes, when the accused was brought back?
- A. 70 No, there were no recoveries at all.
- Q. 71 Are we to understand that the articles picked up at the accused's home were not credited to him?
- A. 71 No, he is still short of some articles, Sir.
- Q. 72 No, that's not the question--- What was the date when some of the articles of the accused's kit were collected at his home?
- A. 72 That was about three weeks back.
