WORST NEW YORK FIRE IN YEARS

Damage by Blaze Which OFFICIAL WHO Swept Three Acres at \$1,500,000 -- Raged Three Hours.

New York Oct. 3.—Fire in the vicinity of 24th street and 11th avenue early tonight swept an area 500 by 300 feet, causing damage estimated

at \$1,500,000.

Chief Croker announced that it was the greatest burned area during his experience in New York city.

The space swept comprises almost thre acres of lumber yards, factories and stables on 11th avenue, and 24th and 25th streets. For nearly three hours the fire was beyond the control of the fire department and it was stopped at leasth, by conceptrating.
