CLOSING LETTER OF N. Y. MARKET BY E. C. RANDOLPH

New York, Oct. 20.—The market was slightly firmer in the afternoon than it had been before midday, due to the fact that the selling pressure was diminished. Those who have been overselling stocks have been careful not to overstep the market to such an extent that a sharp reaction would occur and notwithstanding the technical position at present is not good, there may be no important reaction until unfavorable news of some kind is out. The exchange market is weaker as a result of the record breaking volume of exports from this country. A few of the specialties have been very strong, new records being made by B. S. STU and one or two other stocks. It is reported that the present B S stock will be exchanged for a new issue on a basis of one share of the present security for 10 of the new. Copper stocks eased off a little in the afternoon but appeared to be wanted on the recession. Some sales of the metal have been reported higher than 18 cents a pound, and some large export orders are in prospect. Total sales, 910,000. Bonds, \$4,470,000. E. C. RANDOLPH.
