We are decidedly in favour of guarding sufficiently every point, both in the formation and administration of the government of the Church, from which any danger to the peace and privileges of any portion of the Church may be apprehended; and especially such as have afforded means formerly to make innovations, and intrude upon the rights of the membership.

And now, beloved, we conclude with our earnest prayers to the Great Head of the Church, that He would vouchsafe to have you and us in His holy care and keeping. And may "the God of peace sanctify you wholly, and preserve you blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.—Amen."
