Is a Lumber Merchant; President of the St. George's Society, Ottawa, a director of the Ottawa Association of Lumber Manufacturers, and of the Mada-waska River Improvement Co., and a mem. of the Council of the Ottawa Board of Trade. Has been a mem. of the Corporation of the City of Ottawa. Represented Rideau division in the Leg. Council, Can., from 1862 until the Union. Called to the Senate by Royal Proclamation, May, 1867.—*Bridge St., Ot-tawa.*
