ried by Act, shall remain and continue in force and be observed by an and singular the Courts hereby established, and by the Judges thereof; and more particularly that the said Courts of King's Bench, in their respective districts, in all causes of Criminal Jurisdiction to be constituted therein, shall be governed in its practice and course of proceedings by the Laws prescribing the modes of practice, in causes of a similar nature, for the Courts of Common Pleas, prior to the passing of this Act, and in all causes that may be brought up by appeal into either of the said Courts of King's Bench, the same Courts shall form rules for proceedings therein, as nearly as may be, to the Laws prescribing the rules of proceedings in cause brought before the Court of Appeals; and the Provincial Courts, created by this Act, shall be governed in their practice, and course of proceedings in the same manner and in like cases as the Courts of Common Pleas for the districts of Quebec and Montreal were governed by the Laws of this province, before the passing of this Act.
