Ordered. That the Report be now received, and

The said amendments being twice read by the Clerk, and the question of concurrence put on each, they were severally agreed to.

On motion of the Honorable Mr. Mitchell, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Campbell,

it was.

Ordered, That the said Bill be read a third time to-morrow.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day the House proceeded to the consideration of the amendments proposed by the Committee of the Whole to the Bill intituled, "Act to make "further provision for the Government of the North West Territories," and

The said amendments being again read by the Clerk,

On motion of the Honorable Mr. Campbell, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Mitchell. it was

Ordered, That the same be agreed to.
Ordered, That the said Bill be read a third time presently.

The said Bill was then read a third time accordingly.

The question was put whether this Bill shall pass?

It was resolved in the affirmative.
