Provided always, and be it enaded by the Authority Monies iffued afozesaid, That whatever Monies thall be so issued out of out of the Sinking Fund, the said Surplusses, Excesses, Dverplus Monies, oz other to be replaced Revenues composing the Sinking Jund, hall, from time out of the first to time, be replaced by and out of the first Supplies to be then after granted in Parliament; any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding.

Provided always, and it is hereby enacted by the Au- Monies arifing thority aforesaid.
