to the persons interested, and in case of nonpayment by the party liable for the same, he may be sued by the party in whose favor the indemnity shall have been awarded, for the recovery thereof, in any of his Majesty's Courts of King's Bench.

XVII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that nothing in this Act contained, shall extend or be construed to weaken, diminish or extinguish the rights and privileges of His Majesty, his heirs and successors, nor of any person or persons, body politic or corporate, except such as are affected by this Act.

XVIII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that this Act shall be deemed a public Act, and as such shall be judicially taken notice of by all Judges, Justices of the Peace, and all other persons whomsoever, without being specially pleaded.
