If he engages a competent and reliable architect, he will as a general rule get what he wants, or something very near to it. Had the city done this in the building of the Garrison Creek sewer, there would have been no complaints to make about soft bricks and a deficiency of cement. Contractors might be trusted to do the work, which would do away with the objection as to "soldiering" by the mean.




