

Our university administration wants parking fees for unreserved decals to jump 19 % to \$120 next year.

WE SAY...



- •York University Vice-President Finance Bill Farr promised students that this year's enormous 31% increase in parking fees would be a 'one-time-only' affair.
- •Now the administration wants students to pay 19 % more this year for parking at York. Unreserved parking decals will have risen from \$80 last year to \$120 next year -- and there is a good possibility of more major hikes in the future!
- •The Presidential Advisory Committee on Parking wants students who purchase *unreserved* decals to pay for the construction of *reserved*, service, and daily-rate parking lots, such as the one being built for the York Lanes complex.
- •Students at York are already being forced to endure an 8 % hike in tuition fees, residence rent increases of between 6.5 and 16.5%, the GST on textbooks, and the rising cost of living in Toronto.
