Sir:

I have the honor to inform the department, that the Indian agent, Moose Mountain, has made a requisition for authority to purchase about 650 feet lumber and 3 1/2 m shingles, wherewith to floor and roof a log house 16 feet square to be built and occupied by the interpreter of his agency.

The estimated cost of the same is \$38.<sup>00</sup>

As at present there is no provision for this employe I would recommend that the above request be granted
