Did you at any time see Sgt Featherstone strike McKinnon, when they went outside, did you actually see the physical contact on the face of Gnr McKinnon? Q-171. Where would you say Gnr McKinnon was hit? Q-172. When did you go back into the Pub, at what point A-172. Just after they started wrestling. Q-173. Why did you leave the scene of exitement? A-173. I went back because the police were coming. Cross examined by the Prosecution. Q-174. Did you come over with this Regiment Originally ? A-174. Yes, sir. A-174. ies, sir.
Q-175. Did you know McKinnon in Canada ?
A-175. Yes, sir.
Q-176. What troop areyou in ?

Q-184. When you got to the door did you see Sgt Featherstone on the ground? Q-185. You said that you saw Sgt Featherstone strike McKinnon, where was the Sgt standing just before he struck him?

A-185. He seemed to come out of the room just as they got out.

Q-186. Are you quite sure?

A-186. I am not positive, to the best of my knowledge. Q-187. Where did he strike McKinnon ? A-187. In the face, sir. A-188. Not very far, about 2 paces. Q-189. Q-191. If you were that close to Gnr McKinnon you must have seen what part of McKinnons did Sgt Featherstone hit?

A-191. It seemed to be his face, I would say it was part of his face.

Q-192. Couldn't it have been his shoulder? Q-192. Couldn't it have been his shoulder?

Q-193. What did you see in the light, anything wrong with Sgt !
A-193. Not that I could see, sir.
A-194. When you came up behind, did you stand in the doorway? in the light, anything wrong with Sgt Featherstone? A-194, No, sir, I stepped aside.11/
