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- Q-167. You are certain it is the positive truth?  
A-167. I saw him take a drink.  
Q-168. Did he take one or many?  
A-168. I wouldn't know how much but I saw him take a drink of whiskey and there was a beer glass in front of him.  
Q-169. Did you at any time see Gnr McKinnon strike Sgt Featherstone?  
A-169. No, sir.  
Q-170. Did you at any time see Sgt Featherstone strike McKinnon, when they went outside, did you actually see the physical contact on the face of Gnr McKinnon?  
A-170. Yes, sir.  
Q-171. Where would you say Gnr McKinnon was hit?  
A-171. In the face, sir.  
Q-172. When did you go back into the Pub, at what point?  
A-172. Just after they started wrestling.  
Q-173. Why did you leave the scene of excitement?  
A-173. I went back because the police were coming.

Cross examined by the Prosecution.

- Q-174. Did you come over with this Regiment Originally?  
A-174. Yes, sir.  
Q-175. Did you know McKinnon in Canada?  
A-175. Yes, sir.  
Q-176. What troop are you in?  
A-176. A troop.  
Q-177. That is his troop?  
A-177. Yes, sir.  
Q-178. Did you drink with him on the evening of 30 Oct?  
A-178. No, sir.  
Q-179. You didn't buy him a drink?  
A-179. No, sir.  
Q-179. Did you see Sgt Featherstone and Gnr McKinnon go out?  
A-179. I saw them go out together.  
Q-180. Did Sgt Featherstone grab hold of McKinnon's arm?  
A-180. I am not sure, sir.  
Q-181. Did you hear any of the argument between Gnr Perry and McKinnon?  
A-181. No, sir.  
Q-182. How far away were you when Gnr McKinnon and Sgt Featherstone got to the door?  
A-182. A few paces.  
Q-183. Then what happened, was there anyone between you and the Sgt?  
A-183. I believe there was one or two.  
Q-184. When you got to the door did you see Sgt Featherstone on the ground?  
A-184. No, sir.  
Q-185. You said that you saw Sgt Featherstone strike McKinnon, where was the Sgt standing just before he struck him?  
A-185. He seemed to come out of the room just as they got out.  
Q-186. Are you quite sure?  
A-186. I am not positive, to the best of my knowledge.  
Q-187. Where did he strike McKinnon?  
A-187. In the face, sir.  
Q-188. How far were you when the punch was thrown?  
A-188. Not very far, about 2 paces.  
Q-189. You could see nothing clearly, the light came on then you saw him strike Gnr McKinnon?  
A-189. Yes, sir.  
Q-190. McKinnon reeled back?  
A-190. Yes, sir.  
Q-191. If you were that close to Gnr McKinnon you must have seen what part of McKinnon's did Sgt Featherstone hit?  
A-191. It seemed to be his face, I would say it was part of his face.  
Q-192. Couldn't it have been his shoulder?  
A-192. It was definitely his face.  
Q-193. What did you see in the light, anything wrong with Sgt Featherstone?  
A-193. Not that I could see, sir.  
Q-194. When you came up behind, did you stand in the doorway?  
A-194. No, sir, I stepped aside.

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
