SURRENDER OF TIMBER

Rnow all men by these presents, THAT WE, the undersigned Chief and Principal men of the Chemainus Band of Indians, resident on our Reserve at Chemainus No. 13 in the district of Oyster province of Brit. Columbia Dominion of Canada, for and acting on behalf of the whole people of our said Band in Council assembled, do hereby release, remise, surrender, quit claim and yield up unto our SOVEREIGN LORD THE KING, his Heirs and successors forever, ALL AND SINGULAR, the merchantable TIMBER on our Reserve known as Chemainus No. 13 (N. part) in the province of Brit. Columbia Dominion of Canada, which comprises an area of 842 acres, more or less

and forms the Northern portion of the said reserve, which was not previously released for purposes of sale

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto HIS MAJESTY THE KING, his Heirs and successors forever, IN TRUST to SELL the same to such person or persons, and upon such terms as the Government of the Dominion of Canada may deem most conducive to our welfare, and upon the condition that all moneys received from the sale thereof shall be credited to the funds of our Band, and interest thereon paid to us in the usual manner.

PROVIDED HOWEVER that not exceeding fifty per cent of the moneys derived from the sale of the said TIMBER, shall be distributed to us in accordance with the provisions of Section No. 92 of the Indian Act.
