Montreal Power has receded from last week's figures and closed with 94 $\frac{1}{2}$ bid, a loss of 3 full points for the week, and the quotation to-day is the same as two weeks ago. The transactions, however, were not large and only totalled 1,095 shares. There are still rumours and counter rumours regarding the acquisition of the Lachine Company, but apparently they are only rumours, for nothing of a definite nature has, we are informed, taken place.
