No transfers can be made between the 20th inst. inclusive and the 1st prox. inclusive, as the books must be closed during that period.

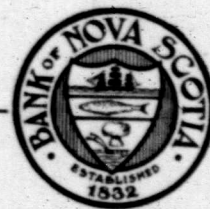
