CAP. VI.

An ACT to AMEND an Act, intituled " An Act for regulating the FISHERIES " in the different Rivers, Coves and "Creeks of this Province" fo far as the fame respects the FISHERIES in that Part of the County of Northumberland which is within the Bay and River MIRAMICHI and it's Branches. Passed the 12th March, 1796.

HERE AS in and by an act made and passed in the Premble. thirty third year of His Majesty's Reign intituled, " An Act for regulating the Fisheries in the different Rivers, " Coves, and Greeks, of this Province" it is enacted 'That the fisheries in that part of the county of Northumberland which is within the Bay and River Miramichi and its branches shall be regulated in the manner therein after mentioned, that is to fay, that the Justices of the Peace in the said county in their first General Sessions in each year shall divide the said Bay and River Miramichi and its branches as nearly as may be into five equal diffricts according to the number of permanent Settlers and thall appoint a certain time and place for the Inhabitants of each respective district to meet and choose two persons the best qualified for that purpose from their knowledge of the fisheries and situation of the Bay and River, all which persons, o so chosen, shall forthwith meet together and proceed to make and form fuch Rules and Regulations for carrying on the fitheries fo far as respects the length of Nets in the said Bay and River, as they or the majority of them thall think the best and most proper to be adopted for the year ensuing; which Rules and Regulations are to be returned and submitted to • the faid Justices in their General Sessions to be held for that · purpose to be by the said Justices either rejected or approved of, confirmed and established under such penalties and torseitures, not exceeding the fum of ten pounds, as to the faid Justices shall · feem meet and necessary for carrying the same into execution; and that fuch rules and regulations thall be observed and obeyed • by the Overseers of the Fisheries to be, by the said Justices, ap-· pointed in the several districts agreeable to the provisions of that
