" and adopt such Measures as may turther reduce

"To make Amendments to fuch Laws as may require them; and to revive fuch others as may have been found useful, but will expire with this Session.

- You may be affured of my ready Concurrence with you, in whatever other Business may offer,
- " and which shall be deemed necessary to be done during your Sitting that may tend to promote
- " during your Sitting, that may tend to promote this Majetty's Service and the general Interest of
- " his Majesty's Service, and the general Interest of this Province.
- "The Treasurer shall lay before you the State and Condition of the Province Funds, together with such other Papers as relate thereto.
- "I recommend that Dispatch in the public Bu"finess, which a due Attention to your private
  "Concerns requires".
