The daughter of a mechanical engineer at Stafford, this girl, by exploits that rival Mme. Humbert and Cassie Chadwick, rose to the heights of luxury of which she dreamed when an invalid school girl.

She spoke in a whisper, she looked so innocent, that she was known as the "White Angel." On her simple statement that she had "great expectations" of a big fortune, brokers gave her stocks, landlords gave her mansions and fine estates, garagekeepers gave her automobiles, shopmen gave her jewels and furs and title suitors asked her hand.

PACT REACHED IN THIS STRIKE

Five Thousand Granite Workers Return to Labors at Greatly Increased Scale of Wages.

BARRÉ, Feb. 19.—Five thousand granite cutters in Washington County who have been idle since November 13 last will return to work next week. An agreement in the nature of a compromise, submitted by the manufacturers to the union this week was accepted today by the Barre branch of the International Granite Cutters' Union, the controlling body in this county, by a majority of about 100 votes.
