Synopsis of Canadian North-west Land Regulations.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency of the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

Duties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain conditions a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section of available Dominion land in each of three years. Duties—Must reside six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra. A homesteader who has exhausted the homestead right cannot obtain a pre-emption may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$20.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$200.00.

CRAZY DEED.

Hours of Prayer Follow Murder of Wife.

Mother Killed by the Side of Her Daughter.

PRIESTHOOD, Oct. 11.—A night spent in prayer and meditation by Martin Shulick was ended when the first shafts of light broke through the window of his home in Clairton this morning by the killing of his wife, Catherine. With two heavy blows from a griddle, Shulick it is said crushed the skull of his wife, the cries of his 7-year-old daughter, Josephine, who lay in bed with her mother, having no effect on the father and husband. Shulick, after cautioning the child to secrecy, fled. It is believed he has gone to the police. The only cause assigned is an unresolvable temper and jealousy. To neighbors, Shulick made no secret of his wife's death, but admitted to the police that he could find nothing against her. For the past three or four weeks quarrels in the little home of the Shulicks have been numerous. The wife complained to the police, but when pressed to make information against her husband, she refused, declaring if she did her husband would kill her.

FOR BISHOPS.

New Rules Presented by Pope—Visit Every Five Years.

ROME, Oct. 11.—New rules affecting the bishops throughout the world were made known at the Vatican to-day. These prescribe that the bishops shall be allowed two years following their appointment in which to arrange the canonical visitations in their dioceses. Five years after that they must satisfy the obligation of visiting the Pope, such visits to be repeated once in every five years.
