A Serious Stabbing Affray in St. Thomas.

First Annual Convention of Oxford Y. P. C. E. Societies.

Death of the Richest Man in Elgin—Mr. Ingram, M.P., Will Get the St. Thomas Postmaster's Office—Woodstock and Tilsonburg People Left Fortunate.

ERANT.

Word has been received in Brantford of a melancholy accident to a farmer named Phelps, of Oakland, on Friday. He was going to Brantford market with wood, and when passing between that village and Scotland the load upset, killing him instantly. Deceased was a middle-aged man with a wife and family.

Word has been received in Brantford of the death of Alfred Bates at London. He was a former Brantford boy and left there two years ago. He was attacked with a gripe early in the winter and succumbed the other day. He was buried at Urbana, Ohio.

ELGIN.

Zene Albertson, a young Yarmouth farmer, was stabbed with a jack-knife in the head by a companion named William McVey in the Duke House at London, on Saturday. The two had been drinking together and the attack was apparently provoked. Dr. Day was summoned and found a ragged scalp wound, about three inches in length, which cut the bone of the skull, severed the main arteries, and bled profusely. The victim was removed to the Amasa Wood Hospital, where he became delirious. His condition is reported to be somewhat easier.

Says the St. Thomas Times (Conservative): "A rumor has been current for the last few days that a secret meeting of the executive of the Elgin Conservative Association, held at the Elgin Hotel, on Saturday, when Mr. Ingram, M.P., attended, that those present pledged themselves to his support for appointment as postmaster of St. Thomas. Members deny that any such pledge was made at the meeting. It is understood, however, that Mr. Ingram, M.P., will eventually receive the appointment of postmaster in this city and that Mr. W. H. Ingram will then resign the collectorship of customs. It is altogether probable that an election for the Commons will take place during the coming summer."

No less than thirty of the Elgin Conservatives are to be married this week. They are all well-known young ladies, and will create quite a gap in society circles.

There died at his home near Clearville, in Aldborough, on Friday, Mr. John Lee, said to be the richest man in the county of Elgin, his wealth being estimated at in the neighborhood of \$300,000. He made most of his money in the township of Burford, where he owned a large amount of fine timber land. When he removed to Aldborough he made large purchases of land, and is said to have owned altogether about 3,500 acres in Ontario, besides large interests in Michigan. He was 80 years of age. His remains were on Saturday taken to Troy, near Galt, and interred on Sunday. He leaves four sons and three daughters.

ANOTHER SUDDEN DEATH.

Richard Hall Ruptures a Blood Vessel and Dies Without a Helping Hand—The Inquest.

An inquest was held last night on the remains of the late Richard Hall, a man about 64 years of age, who was found dead in his bedroom at noon yesterday. The inquest was held in the little back kitchen of his late residence, 566½ Richmond street. The room was a very small one, about 10x12 feet in dimensions, and it was crowded the coroner, sixteen able-bodied jurors, a policeman, a doctor, two medical students, one or two on-lookers and a witness, when called for. A stove, with a kettle singing merrily, a pile of wood, and a table occupied more room and added somewhat to the discomfort of the jurors, who were sitting in some instances on one another's laps. Coroner Flock was in charge, and the following jury was empaneled: Thos. Brown (foreman), Wm. Slater, Wesley Webb, Robt. M. Graham, Robt. Ironsides, John Jones, Chas. Fitzgerald, Samuel Jenkins, William McFarlane, John G. Noyes, Albert Johnston, Henry E. Turner, Chas. Altman, Henry Tozer, Thomas Trebilcock and John Cruickshank. After viewing the remains the evidence of the man's daughter, Frances Hall, was heard. She said her father had arisen that morning as usual about 6 a.m. He made the fire, had breakfast, and when he went to work about 6:45 he was sweeping paths in the yard. When she returned again at noon she found him with a towel in his hand lying face downward in his room. She ran screaming from the house and brought in some neighbors. Deceased was not quite in his usual health, but had complained of nothing beyond a headache. He was of a cheerful disposition and punctually correct in his habits.

The witness was still suffering from shock, and told her story amid many tears and sobs. She is a native of the Emerald Isle, having come to this country with her father about two years ago.

Thos. Morkin was the first man on the scene. He raised the dead man and wiped some blood off his face and forehead. He was cold in the extremities, and had been dead for some time. He telephoned for Dr. Mitchell right away. The deceased was of a cheerful disposition, not at all given to moroseness, and the witness did not think he would take his own life. The razor that was found near the body had probably been used in shaving a few minutes before death came.

Mrs. Lena Riley, the next door neighbor had heard nothing out of the way. The last she saw of the deceased was about 8:45 that morning. He was then engaged in cutting wood.

Dr. Mitchell made the post-mortem examination. The body was, he said, well nourished. There was an abrasion on the forehead, between the eyes, caused by the fall. The brain was normal and the lungs were slightly congested. All the other organs were in a healthy condition. Death resulted, the doctor said, from aneurism of the ascending aorta. This was interpreted to the jury as a rupture of the large blood vessel leading from the heart. The jury returned a verdict of death from natural causes.

The deceased was of a retiring disposition, living alone with his daughter. He was a native of Ireland and had only been in this country for a couple of years. He is supposed to have been a man of some means, and his neighbors all speak in kind terms of his memory.

Elopers Inherit \$100,000.

Brithcup, Ont., Feb. 20.—Ferdinand Fothich eloped 25 years ago from Switzerland with Magdalena Schewar, accompanied by her two brothers. They went to New York, whence they moved to this city. Since then they have lived here, and have been remarkably frugal. At the time of their elopement the parents of both disinherited them. It has just become known to the children that their parents have died, and a little later they were informed officially that they would inherit the fortune left by them. No wills were left, and the children will receive \$100,000.
