## COAL SHORTAGE IS TO BE INVESTIGATED

American Government to Probe  
Situation in Several Manu-  
facturing Cities.

(Canadian Press.)

Pottsville, Sept. 19.—A telegram received here from the acting secretary of the department of commerce and labor in Washington gives assurance that the United States Government intends to begin at once a detailed investigation of the causes of the short supply of anthracite in New York and New England. The investigation will be a part of the inquiry into certain other aspects of the coal situation now being conducted by the bureau of labor.

Local leaders of the United Mine Workers declare that there is no necessity for a scarcity of coal, and that large quantities of anthracite are now being stored in this region, particularly at Lancaster, where there is said to be enough coal piled to last New York city all winter.

## DR. L. A. WOOD GOES TO EDMONTON COLLEGE

Brilliant Young Londoner Ap-  
pointed to Western Educa-  
tional Institution.

Dr. Louis A. Wood, son of Mr. Geo. Wood, of Central avenue, has received an appointment to the faculty of Robertson Presbyterian College in Edmonton, Alta., to lecture on "Church History and New Testament Exegesis," during the coming winter. Dr. Wood received the notice of his appointment from the board of management of the college. He is a graduate of the University of Toronto, and is a student of the University of Heidelberg, Germany. He has won gold medals three times, and while in Germany was a student of Hans Van Schubert, one of the foremost church historians in Europe.

Dr. Wood will reflect honor on his newly-appointed position in Robertson College. His literary ability has been recognized and favorably commented on. He has recently been engaged in writing an historical work on the life of Joseph Brant for Macmillan's new series, entitled "The Chronicles of Canadian History," and his academic thesis, which dealt with the anti-trinitarian conception, has resulted in high commendation in two continents.

Dr. Wood leaves London for the west about Oct. 1. He was connected with the "Chronicles" of local newspapers some years ago.

Information reached the district attorney's office that Pollok was about to sail for Europe. Acting District Attorney Moss asked Justice Goff for a body attachment in order to insure Pollok's presence in the trial of Lieutenant Becker for the murder of Rosenthal.

"It is true," said Pollok, "that I had booked accommodations on the Amerika and was to have sailed this morning. I notified the district attorney's office that I was going and would be based in three weeks."

"I am the manager of Freddie Welsh, the pugilist. My trip was arranged for the purpose of making a match for him abroad. As far as the Becker case is concerned I am not a very material witness, anyhow; my complete story has been told to the district attorney, and the grand jury, and there is no reason why I should want to avoid going on the witness stand."
