

PUBLIC OWNERSHIP CURBED IN STATES

Former U. S. Railway Official Says Private Interests Too Strong.

COMPARISON MADE

Stratford, July 22.—T. N. Jarvis of New York, former vice-president of the Lehigh Valley Railroad, who, though retired, still acts in an advisory capacity for the company, is spending a vacation at the home of his sister, Miss M. Jarvis, 30 Nile street.

Comparing conditions here with those in the United States, Mr. Jarvis said that Canadian youth has a better chance for advancement than in the United States, Canada, as seen by Mr. Jarvis, is a young country, ideally situated for young men. The foreign element, which is retarding progress in the United States, is not so apparent in Canada, and consequently the country is much further ahead.

"While Canada's National Railway system inspires admiration, it is doubtful if it will call for any emulation on the part of the American railways," said Mr. Jarvis. "Private capital in the United States is too strong to make this possible. Government-owned railways are possible under one condition, and it is rather a remote one—the election of the Lafolette or radical party to power."
