ARTICLE X.

No member shall be allowed the use of the Books of the Library, until he shall have paid his subscription.

ARTICLE XI.

Any member who may be in arrear for one year, in the payment of his subscription, shall be ineligible to vote at elections or to be elected to office. Any member who may be in arrear for two years shall cease to be a member.

ARTICLE XII.

Corresponding Members.

Any person distinguished in science or literature, residing beyond a distance of ten miles from Quebec or from Levis, who may be willing to favor the Scciety with communications, works, or writings on subjects connected with the geographical sciences, may be elected a Corresponding member of the Society.

ARTICLE XIII.

Honorary Members.

Any person distinguished by his official position, by his scientific or literary labors; or by his geographical information, may be elected an honorary member of this Society.

No person shall be proposed as a corresponding, or as an honorary member, unless the council shall have previously made a favorable report of his eligibility and capacity.

All members, of whatever class, shall be entitled to receive gratuitously the published Transactions of the Society.
