This exchange program for up to three students is based on an agreement between the two departments. Students from other departments in the humanities may participate by mutual consent, but in general only students from the two departments take part. The number of exchange students should level out over the next couple of years. Last year, four students from Canada stayed at the Heinrich-Heine-Universität Düsseldorf and two German students went to Ontario.

Applicants have to be enrolled for studies at one department of the humanities at either university. Students with higher academic standing (i.e. third year or fourth year students) are usually preferred.

The departments of either university are responsible for the selection of participants. The exchange agreement covers a tuition waiver. Students assume transportation costs and living expenses.

Students remain enrolled at their home university (German students with special leave status) for the time of the exchange which lasts for one academic year.
